

How add a slit to a Circle Skirt

Required measurements:

Above Slit measurement. The area between the Waist and the start of the Slit.

Work out roughly where you would like the slit to start then measure from your Waist to this point.

How to add a slit to a Quarter Circle Skirt

Layout your skirt piece as close as possible to the below pictures.

Your Selvedge & Crossgrain edges may be on opposite sides depending how you cut it but if you have the wrong side up and fold the same as the pictures, the result will be the same.



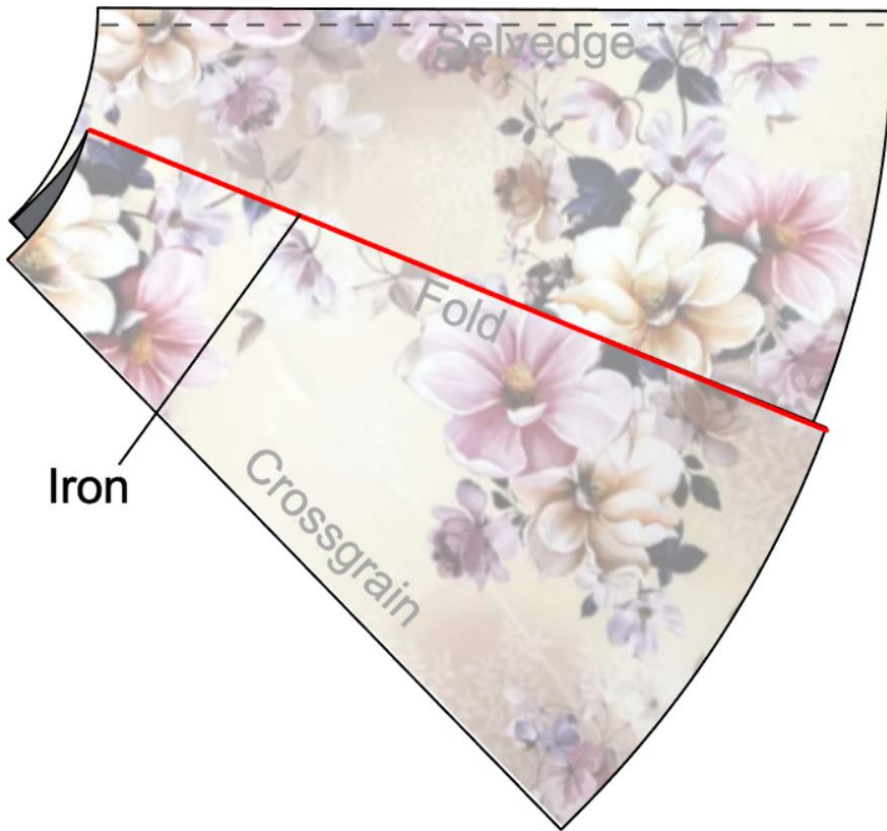
1. Lay the Skirt flat on the floor with the wrong-side up like in the image.



2. Fold the fabric in half.



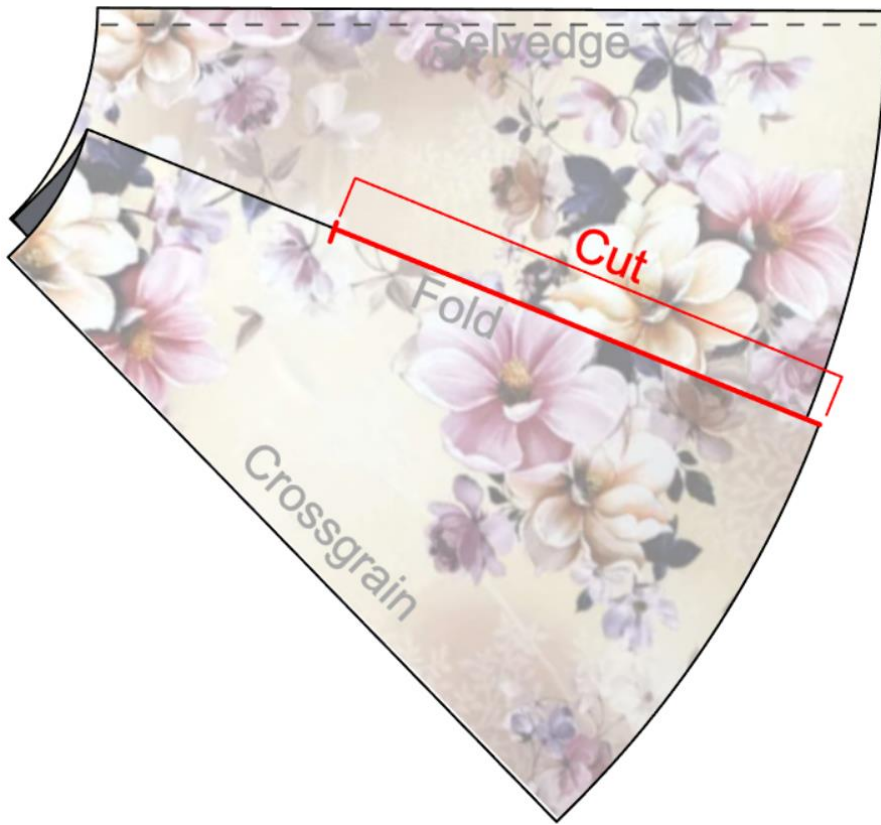
3. Fold again, this time bring the edge towards the fold and extend it past the fold by 1.5cm.



4. Iron this fold.



4. Measure down from the Waistline and along the ironed fold, the Above Slit measurement. Add 2cm to this measurement and make a mark.



5. Cut along the ironed fold until the mark.



Once opened back up and lying right side up, the Skirt will look like this. When worn, the Slit will be on your left leg. If you would prefer the slit on the other leg, simply start with the fabric right side up and follow the same steps as in the pictures above.
