

Crocheted flowers for a quilt
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Material:

Cotton 8/Scheepjes in different colors: mix and match.

Ch= chain DC = double crochet

Clover Soft Touch crochet needle 2,5mm , 2,75mm or 3.0mm

Rnd = round Tr = treble crochet

Sewing a 3D flower on a quilt clothing or pillow: simple and decorative. Crochet the 1st and 2nd rounds. If you want to use this crocheted flower in the center of a Granny Square, make the 3rd row too.

The flower:



Use a chrocet needle 2.5, 2.75 of 3.0mm: chain 8 and slip stitch in first ch to form a ring.

1^e rnd – color A: chain 3 (counts as 1st tr), 2 tr around the ring, ch 6, * 3 tr, ch 6 *, repeat * to * to make 8 groups of 3 tr and ch 6. Slides the groups of 3 tr and ch 6 to fit around the ring. End rnd with a slip stitch. Cast off.

(TIP: weave tails through the stitches)

2^e rnd – color B: begin with a standing dc in the 2nd tr of the previous rnd. Make * 12 tr around the ch 6 of the previous rnd*, repeat * to *, until there are 8 x petals, each with 12 tr. End round with a slip stitch and cast off. .



EXTRA: At the back: begin with a standing dc in the last slip stitch of the previous rnd to make a row of chains for continuing with a Granny Square. Crochet: * ch 5, 1 dc behind the next dc of the previous round, ch 3, 1 dc behind the next dc of the previous round *, repeat * to * until there 4 x 5 ch en 4 x 3 ch. End round with a slip stitch and cast off.

I have not used this round to sew the flowers of my Pineapple quilt: just the first 2 rows – pattern for the Pineapple quilt is available with the BERNINA Blog, February 14 and 22, 2020.
